



## SPHERE PROJECT: HANDBOOK REVISION (2002 – 2003)

### REVIEW GROUP MEETING FOOD SECURITY, NUTRITION AND FOOD AID

**Purpose:** To allow participants (headquarter and international experts) to review the new standards and the revised standards, and to reach consensus on outstanding issues identified by focal points and regional working groups.

**Process:**

In working groups, participants will review text, and address questions developed by focal points.

For each afternoon or morning session, each working group will be asked to review one standard, and address the specific questions developed by focal point. As not all participants will be able to work on every standard during the workshop, prior to the workshop participants will have been asked to review the standards and bring with them their specific comments in writing. These comments will be given to the relevant working group.

A facilitator will be appointed for each group.

Feedback – range of ways; flipcharts, review of flipcharts in a gallery, and annotating drafts

**Key outcomes:**

- Update participants on the process of the revision.
- Approve the field recommendations for the proposed structure for Food Security and Nutrition standards, for the new standards, and for the organization of the chapter.
- For all standards, make corrections and clarifications to the indicators and guidance notes.
- Identify essential outstanding work required for completion of the chapter.
- To further build a commitment to Sphere.
