

**MS/MALD Combined Degree  
Transfer Credit for Transcript Reconciliation Form**

The MS/MALD (Friedman School/The Fletcher School combined degree) award two master's degrees after six full semesters of study, with three full semesters of tuition paid to the Friedman School and three full semesters paid to The Fletcher School; the combined degree is completed in three years, compared with a total of four years to complete the two degree programs individually. For this combined MS/MALD degree students take a total of 24 courses in six semesters (half of these courses are taken at the Friedman School and half are taken at The Fletcher School). Students may count four Fletcher courses toward their Friedman School M.S. degree and may count four Friedman School courses toward their Fletcher Master of Arts in Law and Diplomacy degree.
