- The Non-Degree Special Student tuition for a single NUTR Friedman Degree program course during the 2023-2024 academic year (fall, spring, and summer) is \$6,540/course.

- You MUST submit with this Special Student Application form an unofficial undergraduate or graduate transcript with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0. Submit to: the Friedman School's Registrar.
- Special Student enrollment processing is on a space available basis.
- Special Students must fulfill all registration, and course prerequisites. Your enrollment will not be processed unless the required Tufts University Student Advisory and Health Administration (SAHA) Forms and documentation are completed and submitted to SAHA for approval of your enrollment:
